







ounded in 1927, the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences is the world's preeminent movie-related organization. Best known for the Oscars, the Academy is dedicated to celebrating the art and magic of moviemaking. As part of this mission, the Academy is building the world's premier movie museum in the heart of Los Angeles—the Academy Museum of Motion Pictures. Although not scheduled to officially open until 2017, the Academy will offer a unique preview of the Academy Museum this fall with the world-renowned *Hollywood Costume* exhibition.



lready the holder of one of the world's most significant collections of costume design drawings, the Academy has a long-standing commitment to celebrating costume design and its role in filmmaking. The Academy is excited to present Hollywood Costume, a major multimedia exhibition that explores the central role costume design plays in cinematic storytelling. Originated at the Victoria and Albert Museum (V&A) in London, this ticketed exhibition brings together more than 150 of the world's most iconic costumes, and provides a unique opportunity to see the clothes worn by unforgettable characters from films such as The Wizard of Oz, The Seven Year Itch, Titanic, Dallas Buyers Club, The Hunger Games, Django Unchained and many more. The Academy is enhancing the V&A's presentation and will add over 30 costumes to this landmark show.

Hollywood Costume is curated by eminent Hollywood costume designer Deborah Nadoolman Landis with Sir Christopher Frayling and Keith Lodwick.



rom October 2, 2014 to March 2, 2015, the Academy will offer our friends and partners the opportunity to host special events at the Hollywood Costume exhibition. Located in the landmarked Wilshire May Company building on the corner of Wilshire Boulevard and Fairfax Avenue—the future home of the Academy Museum—Hollywood Costume will offer an elegant and sophisticated setting for both intimate and high-profile events. Entertaining at Hollywood Costume is a privilege reserved for select supporting corporations and nonprofits of the Academy Museum of Motion Pictures. Support from corporations begins at \$15,000 and \$7,500 for non-profits.


